



## *2018 Art in the Park at the Fredericksburg Farmers Market*

**APPLICATIONS:** One (1) annual application shall be submitted for participation as an Art in the Park vendor. This application may be submitted any time prior to the event(s) you will attend. This must be **NO LATER** than close of business (COB) on the Thursday before the first scheduled date you will attend. Applications are to be completed online. Visit our website at [www.thefarmersmarket.co](http://www.thefarmersmarket.co). Click Fredericksburg, then Art in the Park. Rules and Registration links are there. Upon registration, vendors will be charged \$25. This fee **MUST BE PAID PRIOR TO THE FIRST EVENT** and will be credited toward your charges for that day.

Fees are \$25 for a 12' X 12' tent space. Artists/Crafters that do not have a City of Fredericksburg Business License will be required to pay an additional \$10 fee for each Saturday event attending. This is for the required City Event Fee in lieu of the Business License. Payment to participate is due no later than the Thursday before the event and will reserve a space for your set-up on the day or days you have chosen and paid for.

Payment shall be submitted in person at the Dorothy Hart Community Center, 408 Canal St., Fredericksburg VA 22401, by mail, with credit card (540-372-1086, dial extension 0), or online through the PayPal link on the application website.

Available dates are May 5 & 19, June 2 & 16, July 7 & 21, August 4 & 18, September 1 & 15, and October 6 & 20, and December 1, 2018. Fees are non-refundable when events are missed. Art in the Park is expected to be held rain or shine in connection with the Farmers Market. The City of Fredericksburg has discretion to cancel one or more of these events and fees may be reimbursed only if cancelled by the City.

**STANDARDS: All work must be the original fine art or craft created by the exhibiting artist.** It is expected that the artist creating the items will be present during the event. Exhibitors are responsible for all display equipment, set-up, tents, chairs and tables. No materials, electrical or any other item will be provided by Fredericksburg Parks, Recreation, and Public Facilities or the City. Exhibiting artists take full responsibility for the safety of themselves, their family, helpers, and work. They agree to release and hold harmless the Fredericksburg Parks, Recreation, and Public Facilities, as well as the City of Fredericksburg from any and all liability.

**MEDIUMS OFFERED HAVE INCLUDED:** Ceramics/Pottery, Graphics/Printmaking, Painting, Jewelry, Photography, Drawing/Pastels, Metal Work, Sculpture, Fiber/Leather, Mixed Media, Wood, Glass, 3-D Printing and Soaps.

Advertised hours are 9:00 am to 1:00 pm at Hurkamp Park, William and Prince Edward Streets in downtown Fredericksburg, VA. Artists may arrive at 6:00 AM or later to begin setting up or by arrangement with the Market Manager. Sales after 7:00 AM are permitted.

**There is no parking lot for Hurkamp Park. Parking is available in lots adjacent to the market. Exhibitors may only unload at the alley west of the Park or from a parking location. Vendors are not allowed to drive in the park. Register with the Farmers Market Manager on arrival on the day of the event. The Market Manager will request to review a copy of a current City Business License, when applicable. The Market Manager has the authority to ask Artists/Crafters to leave or to refuse an application.**
